As you can imagine, the MJC Board misses our monthly events that give us a chance to see and speak with each of you, give warm hugs, and spend the gift of time with each other.


This has been a challenging few months for all of us, some more than others. Please know that we are keeping good thoughts for the near future when we are once again able to join together and share more great moments.

Should you have any special needs, please feel free to contact any of us on the Board.


